NOTE: In a multi-sport games atmosphere, the mandatory level of participant should be conducive to the many challenges facing participants in a village atmosphere. Recognizing the long term athlete development model, Train to Train level, the designated age classification should be consistent, ensuring a continuum in preparing participants for a higher level of competition.

#### 4.1 Athletes:

All athletes must hold a valid National Competitor Card; all athletes must be a registered member of the Alpine Saskatchewan Ski Association.

All coaches must have as a minimum Entry Level CSCF (Canadian Ski Coaches Federation) certification (a Developmental Level 2 certification is preferred) and be in good standing with the CSCF. Criminal Record Check required.

#### 8.0 RESULTS:

1st = 25 points, 2nd = 20 points, 3rd = 15 points, 4th = 12 points, 5th = 11 points, 6th = 10 points, 7th = 9 points, 8th = 8 points, 9th = 7 points, 10th = 6 points, 11th = 5 points, 12th = 4 points, 13th = 3 points, 14th = 2 points, 15th = 1 point.

#### 9.0 TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:

In the medal events, should a tie occur, dual medals are awarded.

# 10.0 SPORT PROTEST PROCEDURE:



Protests are decided by Race jury appointed according to FIS (Federation International de Ski) rules. A protest fee of \$25 applies and is refunded if the protest is successful.

### 11.0 EQUIPMENT:

Slalom skis, shin guards, helmets (FIS approved for alpine skiing), downhill suits with the exception of the U12 age group. They can wear them if they have them but it is not required.

According to FIS rules (Voting members = Technical Delegate, Chief of Race and Referee; Non voting = Start Referee and Finish Referee)

# 16.0 DISTRICT TEAMS SELECTION CRITERIA

District team selection will be based on:

For each age category (U12, U14, U16), the district team will comprised of the top two male and female competitors from that district, as determined from their race results held in mid-January 2014 at a site to be determined by Alpine Saskatchewan. Alternates to the team will be ranked by the same method.

The race will be a Bachleda format (refer to <a href="https://www.saskalpine.com/LinkClick.aspx?fileticket=0b8PvKI1Kr0%3d">www.saskalpine.com/LinkClick.aspx?fileticket=0b8PvKI1Kr0%3d</a>). Points assignment is determined by placing (i.e. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc) within each age category (U12, U14, U16) in each qualifying race – regardless of athlete district.

Points result is based on World Cup points (see full reference at <a href="www.fis-ski.com/data/document/wcall-edition-2008.pdf">www.fis-ski.com/data/document/wcall-edition-2008.pdf</a> section 10)

assigned for placing in each. Competitors ranking first to 30th (single events and Combined) are awarded points in accordance with the following schedule:
