1.0 SPORT:

- 1.1 Competition Site: Dave G. Steuart Arena
- 1.2 Competition Dates: February 16 – 19, 2014
- 1.3 Sanction: Yes

2.0 PARTICIPANTS

- 2.1 Number of Competitors
 - Men: 4 Women: 10
- 2.2 Coaches and Managers: 2 coaches | 1 manager

Note: Sports that have both male and female competitors must ensure that one coach/manager is male and the other coach/manager is female

3.0 CLASSIFICATIONS:

- 3.1 Year of Birth: January 1st, 2004

Competitors must be ten (10) to sixteen (16) years of age as of January 1st, preceding the Games.

NOTE: In a multi-sport games atmosphere, the mandatory level of participant should be conducive to the many challenges facing participants in a village atmosphere. Recognizing the long term athlete development model, Train to Train level, the designated age classification should be consistent, ensuring a continuum in preparing participants for a higher level of competition.



4.0 ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Athletes: In accordance with the Skate Canada Rule Book

Class 1 Free Skate U12 (Under 12 as of January 1st, 2014)

- Skaters must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Free Skate test but no higher than the complete Senior Bronze free skate test.
- Skaters may have passed one (1) part of the Junior Silver Free Skate test but no higher.

Class 2 Free Skate U15 (Under 15 as of January 1st, 2014)

- Skaters must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Free Skate test but no higher than the complete Junior Silver free skate test.
- Skaters may have passed one (1) part of the Senior Silver Free Skate test but no higher.

Class 3 Free Skate U17 (Under 17 as of January 1st, 2014)

- Skaters must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Free Skate test but no higher than the complete Senior Silver free skate test.
- Skaters may have passed one (1) part of the Gold Free Skate test but no higher.

Class 1 Dance – One (1) partner may have passed the complete Junior Bronze Dance test but no higher complete dance test.

Class 2 Dance – One (1) partner may have passed the complete Senior Bronze Dance test but no higher complete dance test. Both partners must have passed the Junior Bronze dance test.

Class 3 Dance – One (1) partner may have passed the complete Junior Silver Dance test but no higher complete dance test. Both partners must have passed the Senior Bronze dance test.

- Competitors can compete in two (2) events – One (1) single event and one (1) dance event.
- Dance teams from two (2) different Districts must declare their District by December 1st, 2013
- Maximum of three (3) competitors / couple per event per District
- Skaters must meet the test requirements as of November 1st, 2013
- Dance couples must be comprised of one (1) women and one (1) man

4.2 Coaches:

- Primary STARSkate Evaluated (formerly NCCP Level 1 certified)
- All coaches must be registered as Skate Canada Coaching Members for the current skating season
- Coaches must register in person and show their Skate Canada Professional Coach Membership Card which includes their

7.0 COMPETITION:

- 7.1 Type of Competition: Free Skate Single and Dance
- 7.2 Events:

SINGLES (Will consist of one (1) part only – free skate program)

WOMEN AND MEN

(1) Class 1 Free Skate

Skaters will perform a program of two and one half (2.5) minutes in length +/- 10 seconds. Well Balanced program criteria for the Pre-Juvenile will be used. The CPC scoring system will be used.

(2) Class 2 Free Skate

Skaters will perform a program of two and one half (2.5) minutes in length +/- 10 seconds. Well Balanced program criteria for the Juvenile will be used. The CPC scoring system will be used.

(3) Class 3 Free Skate



Skaters will perform a program of three (3) minutes in length +/- 10 seconds. Well Balanced program criteria for the Pre-Novice will be used. The CPC scoring system will be used.

DANCE (will consist of one part only – pattern dances)

- (1) **Class 1 Dance**
Skaters will skate the pattern dances drawn for the 2014 STARSkate competition Junior Bronze Dance event.
- (2) **Class 2 Dance**
Skaters will skate the pattern dances drawn for the 2014 STARSkate competition Senior Bronze Dance event.
- (3) **Class 3 Dance**
Skaters will skate the pattern dances drawn for the 2014 STARSkate competition Junior Silver Dance event.

8.0 RESULTS:

The Cumulative Points Calculation (CPC) Judging System will be used for all event categories.

9.0 TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:

In accordance with the Skate Canada Rule Book.

10.0 SPORT PROTEST PROCEDURE:

In accordance with the Skate Canada Rule Book.

11.0 EQUIPMENT:

Ice surface, skates, appropriate skating attire and music (two (2) CDs).

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the Performing Rights Society.

Competitors, who have music composed especially for their programs, either in wholly or in part, shall be responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and television, or appropriate clearance from the Performing Rights Society.

For the information of Dance competitors: The ISU compulsory dance music to be used for all practices and events is the 2001 Revised Version produced by the ISU.

Music Requirements



Each entry must provide either two (2) CDs for the competition upon registration. One for competition (marked "Master") and one for back up (marked "copy"). If two CDs are provided, it is recommended that a back-up cassette be available. Music will be retained at the Arena.

Standard Specifications for CDs and Cassettes

1. Only one program shall be recorded on each CD.
2. The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in.
3. Competitor's name followed by music time (not skating time) shall be clearly printed on the CD.
4. Each CD shall be enclosed in a plastic case marked with the skater's name, event and total music time.

1. Sport Chairperson, Host Community for sport in question (or designate)
2. Provincial Sport Governing Body Chairperson (or designate)

16.0 DISTRICT TEAMS SELECTION CRITERIA

Registration will be done online through the Skate Canada – Saskatchewan website (www.skatecanadasaskatchewan.com under “Competitions). Run-offs will be held according to the number of entries in each District.

The top (2) women from each Woman’s event will be selected to the team. The remaining team will be determined based on the number of dance teams in each District. The remaining team selected will be done by a Central Selection Committee.
