Recognizing the long term athlete development model, Train to Train level, the designated age classification should be consistent, ensuring a continuum in preparing participants for a higher level of competition.

7.0 COMPETITION:

7.1 Type of Competition: 3 races

7.2 Events: Day 1 Sprint - ski 3 x 1 km loops shoot 2 times , penalty loops for a miss, individual starts 1 minute or 30 sec apart.

Day 2 Mass Start - ski 4 x 1km loops shoot three times , penalty loops for a miss, start each category separately

Day 3 Relay Male Relay, Female Relay

9 teams of 4 athletes , mass start 3 x 1 km loops for each skier , each athlete shoots twice and does penalty loops for a miss (allowed three extra pellets each time shooting to hit all five targets)

Juveniles - use CZ or Daisy 853 pellet rifles with a rest

Juniors - use CZ or Daisy 853 pellet rifles with no rest

Pellet rifles supplied by Biathlon Saskatchewan



8.0 RESULTS:

First place awarded points equal to the number of competitors in the age group. Second place gets one less and so on. The first place relay team receives 10 points x the number of zones. Second place gets that number minus ten and so on.

9.0 TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:

Based on Time in Mass Start race

10.0 SPORT PROTEST PROCEDURE:

Submit protest to Jury 15 min after preliminary results are posted.

11.0 EQUIPMENT:

Biathlon Sask will supply pellet rifles and targets.

The range will consist of 12 lanes, each lane is 2 m wide and requires a 5 foot by 5 foot rug (shooting mat) . Straw (square bails) can be used for a backstop. The shooting distance is 10 meters

Trails needed are a 1 km loop and a 1.5 km loop (approximate distances are fine) and a 100 m penalty loop near to the range.

Appointed at race, consists of chief of range, chief of competition and a coach appointed at race
