MANDATORY Submit Your Commitment Fee, Proof of Vaccination, and Criminal Record Check

Here is what you need to know:

- All volunteers that have registered for the 2022 Saskatchewan Winter Games are required to submit a \$20 commitment fee (cash only), proof of COVID-19 vaccination and consent to a criminal record check (CRC).
- CRCs for all Regina residents will be run by the Regina Police Service. If you currently reside in Regina, please complete the [Police Information Check Consent Form -2022 SK WINTER GAMES](#).
- You will be required to present this form along with two pieces of valid government ID, your proof of vaccination, and \$20 (cash only) to a Saskatchewan Winter Games staff member in person.
- The office is located at 280 - 1870 Albert St. Regina, SK S4P 4B7.
- Regina Police Service will provide the results of your CRC directly to the 2022 Saskatchewan Winter Games as a pass or fail notification.

Drop-off dates:

- December 22 & 29: 9 a.m. - noon
- Beginning January 3, we will be available:
 - Mondays from 9 a.m. - noon
 - Wednesdays from 9 a.m. - noon and 5 - 8 p.m.
 - Fridays from 1 - 4:30 p.m.
- January 6: 5 - 8 p.m.
- January 25: 5 - 8 p.m.
